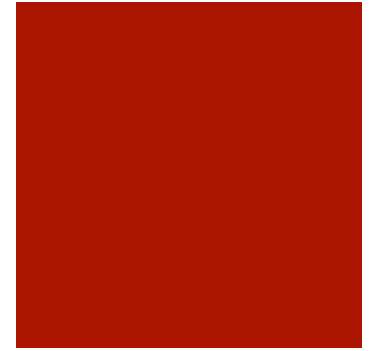




Point of View & Narrator

What is point of view?

- Merriam-Webster: “a position of perspective from which something is considered or evaluated”
- **1st person:** spoken voice, personal; I, me, mine, we, us, our
- **2nd person:** speaking to the reader; you, your, yourself
- **3rd person:** written voice, formal; he, she, it, him, her, them, their



Fahrenheit 451 Point of View



- 3rd person limited-omniscient
 - 3rd person: he, she, them
 - Limited: follows Montag's point of view, articulating his interior monologues
 - Omniscient: narrator has knowledge about several characters

 - It should not be biased.
